Information about TOEFL

The Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) is a multiple-choice language test that takes approximately 4 hours. The test is offered in an internet-based and paper-based format.

The TOEFL is divided into four sections: Reading, Listening, Speaking, Writing. The Listening section contains dialogues with changing pronunciation and various accents. In the Writing section two essays are to be written.
